#### School Improvement Update - Education Scotland and Care Inspectorate joint inspection

We would like to thank all the parents and carers who supported our recent inspection either through completing questionnaires, or offering their time to meet with the visitors. This is always a valuable experience to validate the self-evaluation work of any school, whilst identifying any specific areas of strength and next steps. After the visit, the team gather their findings in a report that is then moderated at Education Scotland level before being published. A letter to all families is sent to the school for us to share with you all. This will be sent to you all as soon as we can. As a staff team, we will then spend time exploring the summary of findings to inform our action planning for continuous improvement.

At our most recent in-service day after the October break, staff attended training with West Lothian College on outdoor learning, including the use of our new fire pit area that has been installed in the grounds. This will be a shared area for both school and nursery children to enhance our outdoor learning. We also spent time looking at national changes in the curriculum as well as staff health and wellbeing. Recent collegiate time on Friday afternoons has been spent working with our cluster colleagues on moderation of numeracy, which will continue later in November.

## Wider Achievements

We have a new tracking system for wider achievements to reflect both home and school interests. Please do encourage your child to share any achievements out with school – we do love to hear all about the wonderful things our children do beyond school!
